following questions regarding the Justice Street Project Out to Bid:

- There are several inlets that read as "Reconstruct" (A-1 is an example) however there is
 no "Reconstruct Type _, Inlet" pay item. How are we getting paid for this scope of
 work? Reconstructed inlets shall be paid for under the appropriate "Inlet, Type __"
 pay item. The term "Reconstruction" notes that there is an existing inlet in the
 approximate location and that there may be existing connections that need to be
 maintained.
- Please confirm that the Type B Inlets that are to be installed with driveway access
 plates (B-6 is an example) will be paid under the Type B inlet Item, or will a separate pay
 item be added for the inlets with driveway plates? No separate pay item will be added
 for inlets with driveway backplates, they will be paid under the Type B inlet item.
- Please confirm that both Type Double B Inlets are the "Detention Basin Inlets" and separate pay items are not necessary. Inlets A-5 and C-9 shall be paid for under the "Type Double B" pay item. Specific details are provided for these structures on Sheet 28 "Construction Details 5"

- The plans propose that Inlet C-5 be converted from a Type B Inlet to a Type E inlet, how are we getting paid for this work? Based on a review of the proposed quantities, it appears that this work was included under the "Inlet, Type B" pay item.
- Are trash racks or weirs required to be added at the end of the Headwalls or just the
 Flared End Sections? Check valves are required at the end of the headwalls at the
 downstream most portion of the project. No trashracks or weirs were called for in the
 plans or specifications.
- Which manhole casting does the township want? The detail references both a 1202B and a 1203 as well as a watertight casting, does the township want any markings stamped on the cover? Manhole castings shall be Campbell pattern 1202B with watertight Flow Seal gasket.
- Do storm sewer trenches need to be paved at the end of each working day? There is no
 requirement to pave the trenches, but no trench shall be left open overnight. Access
 shall be maintained on a daily basis though adequate backfill, plating, or paving.
